Leafy turnip



- ▶ Fast establishment.
- ▶ Excellent fall livestock/wildlife grazing option.
- ▶ High sugar content along with low nitrates provides high quality forage with great digestibility.
- ▶ Dense leaf canopy suppresses weeds and protect the soil from wind and water erosion.
- ▶ Vigorous tap root system promotes soil biology and improved soil structure.
- ▶ Good winterhardiness allows nutrients to be protected against leaching and available for the following crop.

**Jupiter** leafy turnip is a high-yielding forage brassica variety known for its excellent winterhardiness and rapid growth. Jupiter is a great fit in any livestock and wildlife system as a high-protein, high energy feed during late fall and winter when other forage options are limited.

**Jupiter** leafy turnip is also a versatile and resilient cover crop that enhances soil health, improves nutrient cycling, and supports environmentally sustainable agriculture.



## MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS:

Planting Dates – August/September

Planting Rate – Forage Production: 7-9 lb./acre; Cover Crop: 9-14 lb./acre

Planting Depth – 3/4" to 1"
